
### General Hints and Tips (Rob)


- Advance Planning
- Aperture no wider than f7.1
- Raw versus JPG
- Ignore shadows on the backdrop
- Histogram will load to the left this is okay
- Setting white balance at start














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








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# When would you ever shoot jpg?

- Convenience: posting that 'Instagram' moment (use your phone?)
- Speed (e.g. tether to computer to deliver instantly to news editor)
- Buffer capacity for continuous shooting
- If you don't own a computer
- If you're happy for a technician in Thailand to do your editing for you

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### **General Hints and Tips**

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#### General studio etiquette when organising a photoshoot (Sharon)

- Leapfrogging
- Each person has a time, not a number of shots
- Use an alarm and appoint a timekeeper
- Five minutes is plenty of time
- Give up your place if you get stuck
- Don't go over time "just one more shot"
- Accept that other people will steal your ideas
- Plan while other people are shooting

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- The model may well be nervous too
- Be polite and friendly to models
- Take test shots first and explain why
- Try to help models relax
- Don't touch a model (even to move hair)

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
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- Explain shot to model (whole body, head etc)
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
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
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
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- Shoot portraits after role play

- Black on Black



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


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
