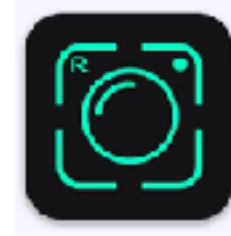

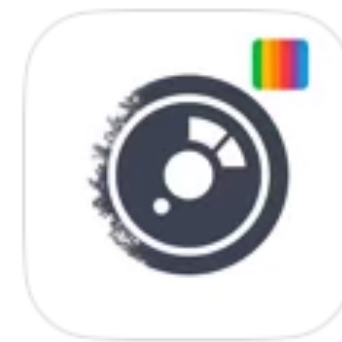

The site (Tin Rocket) offers other creative apps as well as a desktop version.

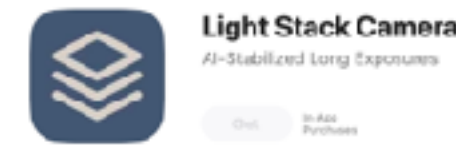
